- 2. The **Public Auction** will be held at Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Dudhnoi, Goalpara-783124 on **30/08/2024** at **11.00 A.M onwards.**
- 3. All interested parties are requested to attend the auction on the above specified place and time. The party quoting the highest rate shall be awarded the auction sale.
- 4. During the auction process, acceptance or rejection of a bid will be announced immediately on the stroke of the hammer.
- 5. The bidder should check the animals for all aspects before bidding. No complaints will be entertained once the bidding formalities are over.
- 6. The highest bidder will have to deposit the whole amount by account transfer, RTGS, POS, Swipe machine available with the cashier on the same day of bidding. UTR No./Deposit slip towards deposit of the bid amount should be submitted to the farm In-charge to obtain delivery of the Pigs.
- 7. The purchaser will have to lift the animal(s) from the farm within the next three days of successful bidding. In case, he fails to do so, management and feeding cost of Rs. 500/- per day per animal will be charged. The Institute will not be held responsible for illness or death of the animals after deposit of the bid value by the successful bidder.
- 8. The successful bidder shall have to make their own arrangement for lifting of the animals and in no case auctioned animals will be allowed to be kept in the farm for more than 7 days failing which the Institute will be free to dispose off of the animals suitably.
- 9. The bidders should take precautionary measures for the safety of the workers while lifting/transporting of Pigs.

- 10.
