About the workshop

The workshop is envisaged to impart knowledge and skills pertaining to scientific pig production as well as value addition of pork to the prospective entrepreneurs.

- Good management practices to be followed in pig farms.
- Basic criteria for selection of breed/varieties/ strain and breeding strategies for profitable pig farming.
- Principles of feeding of different categories of pigs and appropriate strategy for use of conventional as well as non-conventional feed stuffs for pig feeding.
- Housing requirements, care and management for different categories of pigs.
- Process of collection, processing and evaluation of Boar semen for Artificial Insemination in pigs.
- Common bacterial, viral and parasitic diseases of pigs and their management.
- Bio-security aspects and the preparedness required to tackle the challenges with respect to new and emerging diseases associated with pigs.
- Hygienic pig slaughter operations and value addition of pork.
- Addressing specific technological challenges faced by Entrepreneur start-ups in the pork value chain.
