Organized sensitization workshop on 'Enhancing commercial pig production, including organic pig production, in NE India with focus on export prospects' in collaboration with APEDA.

ICAR-National Research Centre on Pig, Rani, Guwahati in collaborator with Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA) has organized a sensitization workshop on 21st September, 2022 on 'Enhancing commercial pig production, including organic pig production, in NE India with focus on export prospects' towards creation of an ecosystem that not only enables the different stakeholders to interact each other but also to tap into the vast market opportunities presented by the domestic as well as export markets. The programme was organized at Sivasagar district of Assam. The programme was intended to create a platform for the stakeholders to interact each other and to tap the domestic and export market opportunities of pork and pork products from India and the North Eastern Region in particular.
