ICAR-National Research Centre on Pig, Guwahati has organized a day long program on “Awareness Camp on Piggery and Input Distribution” in Beberi Para, Dhangar Gaon, Palasbari, Kamrup, Assam on 28th October, 2024 under the Tribal Sub Plan (TSP). In his welcome address, the goan budha/village head expressed gratitude to Dr. Vivek Kumar Gupta, Director of ICAR-NRC on Pig, and the team of scientists for their initiative to support the Rabha farming community. He also expressed hope for continued collaboration in the future. The program was attended by Dr. Juwar Doley, Senior Scientist, Animal Biotechnology and Dr. Priyajoy Kar, Scientist, Agricultural Extension. During their speeches, the scientists discussed the various challenges and opportunities faced by pig farmers and urged the participants to adopt scientific pig farming methods to promote self- entrepreneurship through piggery. They also highlighted the skill-oriented training programs available at ICAR-NRC for pig farmers. As part of the program, 30 steel buckets were distributed to tribal pig farmers in the village. The farmers expressed their gratitude for this initiative and showed great interest in pursuing pig farming on a commercial scale.
