- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 2. - 4. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
- 5. OEM Turn Over Criteria: The minimum average annual financial turnover of the OEM of the offered product during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the OEM is less than 3 year old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.
- 6. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.
- 7. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.
- 8. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.
- 9. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 50% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Generic

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

3. Forms of EMD and PBG

4. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Scope of Work And Terms and Condition of Contract

1. The quantity mentioned in the bid is tentative for the period of one year however, the actual order quantity may change as per the requirement and the firm has no right to claim in this regard.

Supply orders will be issued from time to time based on the actual requirement and payment will be made against the supply of actual order quantity. The firm should complete the supply within 7 days from the date of issue of order.

- 2. The items should be supplied at ICAR-National Research Centre on Pig, Rani, Guwahati, Assam-781131
- 3. The rate should be quoted FOR ICAR-NRC on Pig, Rani, Guwahati i.e. including of all duties, taxes, loading charges, unloading charges and transportation charges upto the destination of consignee location i.e ICAR-NRC on Pig, Rani, Guwahati-781131.

- 4. All losses during transit due to breakage and shortage etc. will have to be borne by the **Firm/Agency** at his own cost.
- 5. The **Firm/Agency** shall not sublet the contract or assigned to any other party or parties in whole or any portion of the contract.
- 6. The supplied items should be as per the specifications as mentioned below.
- 7. The items should be supplied in the sealed Pack. All the materials should be packed in clean and strong bags. The mouth of each plastic or gunny bag shall be either machine stitched or rolled over or hand stitched with strong twine to prevent its accidental opening or rupture.
- 8. Liquidation charges @0.5% per week subject to maximum 10% of order value will be charged from delay in Supply beyond the delivery period as mentioned in the order.
- 9. The firm should submit test report of the samples of the items at the time of supply against each batch failing which the items will not be acceptable.
- 10. Institute will test the samples of the items at the time of delivery and if any discrepancies/changes in the parameters of specifications are noticed, the entire batch of the items will be rejected. The agency shall clear the unaccepted items from ICAR-NRC on Pig, Guwahati at their own cost within a stipulated period of time failing which penalty @ of Rs. 5000.00/per day will be levied for the storage charges.
- 11. The Firm/Agency shall be held responsible for the supply of any spurious/inferior products, the cost involved for the losses and other legal consequences thereon.
- 12. In case of any dispute arising out of this contract or any of the provision herein contained or anything arising here put in respect of matters on which the decision of the Director, NRC on Pig, Rani, Guwahati shall be final and binding on the parties.
- 13. All legal disputes are subject to jurisdiction of Guwahati High Court only.
- 14. Items should be free from any adulteration or use of inferior quality of material. It should be free from dust, stone, lumps of earth clay, mud, chaff straw weed seed, and any other non-food grain.
- 15. Items should be free from rancidity, adulterants, insect or fungus infestation and from fermented musty or other objectionable odours.
- 16. Items should be free from extraneous matter such as dirt, iron and other metallic pieces.
- 17. The firm should have its feed mill/store/warehouse/Authorized dealer in the state of Assam for uninterrupted supply of feed as per requirement.
- 18. Performance Security of an amount equivalent to 3% of the total contract value has to be deposited by the agency within seven days of intimation of the award of the work. The amount shall be refundable without any interest after 2 months of successfully completion of the contract period.
