TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. The agency must provide minimum wage, EPF, ESI and ot her statutory benefits to the persons engaged for Garden Maintenance Work at ICAR-NRC on Pig, Guwahati as per G ovt. of India (Central Govt. India) rules i.e. Minimum rate of Govt. of India must be followed i e Minimum wages as p er the Ministry of Labour & Employment, Govt. of India, ru les and acts applicable for the workers notified for "B ARE A" shall be followed. Further VDA and other statutory allowances to the workers shall also be paid by the agency at

revised rate, whenever the same is revised/enhanced by the Ministry of Labour & Employment, Govt. of India.

- 2. The amount shall be quoted in the price bid by the agenc y for the period of one year (12 months) inclusive of all ta xes and charges after taking into consideration all the as pects as mentioned in the scope of work and terms & con dition of the bid/contract.
- 3. The amount of the contract will be fixed for the period of 1 year (12 months) and no alteration will be allowed at the later stage.
- 4. As the contract amount will be fixed for the period 1 year (12 months) therefore, the agency should quote the amount in the price bid after taking into consideration all the costs like payment of wages to the labours following minimum wages rate, others rules & regulation of govt. of India, cost of material & items as indicated in scope of work and provisions for payment of unforeseen expenditure that may arise in due course like increase in VDA, Statutory Liability- ESI, EPF etc.
- 5. The payment will be made to the agency on monthly basi s by dividing the total contract amount by 12 months.
- 6. The payment will be made only after satisfactory perfor mance, clearance of statutory liabilities and submission of necessary documents in this regard by the agency.

- 7. The agency have to comply the rules and regulations strictly provided by the Ministry of Labour, GOI from time to time and it will be responsible for observ ance of all provisions of Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition)Act 1970 r evised from time to time. The institute will not be responsible for any violation s related to labour management by the successful bidder.
- 8. The contract is for a period of one year initially which may be extended on the approval of Competent Authority and strictly following the conditions of contract failing which contract is liable to be terminated.
- 9. Mode of Payment:

ICAR-NRC on Pig shall make payment through PFMS/ RGTS in favor of the agenc y.

- 10. Termination: This contract can be terminated by giving one month's notice on either side and that any notice required to be served shall be sufficiently served on the parties if delivered to them personally or dispatched at the address herein given under registered post. The ICAR-NRCP will not have any responsibility towards this for any damage/ loss caused and it cannot be challenged in any court of law.
- 11. The contractor is advised to do a complete survey to assess the site and quantum of work of the tender prior submitting the rates/ submission of tender.
- 12. In case of any dispute arising, decision of Director, ICAR-NRC on Pig will be final and binding.
- 13. An amount of 3% of the contract value is to be deposited by the sel ected/ successful tenderer as a security deposit only after receiving communication from the ICAR-NRC on Pig. In the event of non -deposition of the same, the earnest money will be forfeited.
- 14. GST & Other Taxes will be pad as applicable as per Govt. of India rules.
- 15. Director, ICAR-NRC on Pig reserves the right to reduce or terminate the perio d of contract or to extend its duration in the interest of the council/Institute fo r any justifiable reasons, not mandatory to be communicated to the tenderer.
- 16. Incomplete bid or not complying with the above condition is liable to be rejected.
- 17. If the date upto which the bids is open for acceptance is declared to be a holi day the tenders shall be deemed to remain open for acceptance till the next working day.
- 18. No interest will be paid against EMD and security deposit.
- 19. The Agency shall follow the provision of all labour laws applicable to this esta blishment including statutory payments and other liabilities / eventuality labo urers from time to time and will be solely responsible. ICAR-NRC on Pig, Guwa hati will not have any responsibility in this regard in any case/ eventuality.
- 20. If a tenderer does not accept the offer, after issuing of letter of award by ICA R-NRCP within 15 days, the offer made shall be deemed to be withdrawn with out any notice & EMD will be forfeited further the firm may be debarred for a period of 03 years

21. The contractor / Agency shall make payment of remuneration / wages to its p ersonnel before 7th of every month and if required ICAR-NRCP, Rani, Guwahat i may asked the firm to produce a copy of payment vouchers of the workers e mployed by the agency.

The entire cost and liability of any material or other, losses due to negligence fro m part of successful bidder or the persons engaged will be borne by the contract awarded firm

- 22. ICAR-NRC on Pig, Guwahati may ask the agency to produce the documents r egarding payment of wages & statutory liabilities at any time and the agency shall produce the documents accordingly.
- 23. The personal engaged by the agency for this job contract will not be an employee of the council/ICAR-NRC on Pig and there will be no employer- employee relationship between the council/ICAR-NRC on Pig and the personnel so engaged by the contractor.
- 24. The agency shall be wholly responsible for making payment of monthly salari es and other admissible allowances to the personnel under minimum wages act and the council/ICAR-NRC on Pig shall in no way be responsible for meetin g any kind of expenditure on salaries etc. to these personnel individually.
- 25. Only those firms will be considered for financial bid opening who will qualify in the technical bid. Financial bid will be opened of technically qualified firms. The ICAR-NRCP will award the contract to the responsive bidder whose total cost for all the items put together is the lowest. **Terms of the contract**:


